You've got Recital questions? We've got answers!

The costumes for our recital have been ordered and we hope you and your dancer are as excited as we are! In order for recital to run smoothly, we try to anticipate and address all questions which may arise. This month, we will focus on costumes and requirements!

Must my dancer wear tights?

If tights are part of your dancer's costume, tights must be worn. Also, in the case of our ladies, please make sure that your dancer does not wear underwear under her tights.

Can my dancer wear jewelry?

No jewelry may be worn on stage or for pictures, other than small stud earrings and/or accessories that have been assigned. This is a safety measure as well as for uniformity. No necklaces, dangling earrings, anklets, etc. can be worn.

Can my dancer wear nail polish?

Clear nail polish or no nail polish is the requirement and also, no white tips. Dancers wearing colored nail polish will be required to remove it before pictures and performance.

Will I have to buy new shoes for the recital?

All shoes must be the required shoes for the costume. All ballet shoes must have ribbons taped in. All tap shoes and jazz shoes must be the color required for the class and costume. Make sure shoes are labeled with your dancer's name. Also, be sure to wipe off all of your shoes so that they are show ready! Magic erasers work wonders on most shoes. Most importantly, make sure the shoes are the color that is listed as part of your costume on the accessory list you will receive. If you do need to purchase new shoes, do not wait until the last minute or the shoes may not arrive in time for the performance.

What is the best way to keep track of my dancer's costume pieces?

Make sure your dancer's name written is in all costume pieces, including tights, shoes, gloves, sashes, head-pieces, cuffs, etc. We do not have extra costume pieces, so please keep up with each piece of your dancer's costume. Each dancer in your child's class will have the same costume pieces so it is extremely important that everything be marked with your dancer's name.
