IMPORTANT REMINDERS!!

- 1) Tights and recital fees have been charged to accounts!! Your costume fee just includes the cost of the costume/s. Shoes/ tights are also not included in the cost.
- 2) Recital pictures will be taken on April 27 at the studio. The photographer will have proofs in the studio on May 6-7 for you to review and purchase.
- 3) Recital Fee: \$30.00 - Every child participating in recital will be charged a \$30 recital fee. The fee helps to cover the tremendous financial undertaking of producing such a **HUGE** production.
- 4) Tights: Child sizes — \$14.00 *plus applicable sales taxes of 9%
Adult sizes — \$16.00 *plus applicable sales taxes of 9%

Please note: In case of inclement weather—we generally follow what the school systems are doing. If we are going to have to cancel classes, we will notify everyone via email and/ or automatic call from our studio system/ and on our Facebook Group.

What do we need to do when we arrive at the venue on the day of recital?

Parents will enter through the side door of the Performing Arts Center and check in their dancer. The parent and the dancer will each be given an armband. We issue armbands for two important safety reasons: 1) staff members check for armbands to ensure that anyone attempting to enter the backstage area is permitted to be there and 2) we ask that the parent who checked the dancer in be the one to come backstage to assist with costume changes, if needed, and to pick up the dancer when the recital is over.

How will I know where my dancer is to go?

All armbands, as well as dressing rooms, are color coded by dancers' age groups.

How long will the recital last?

The recital will move FAST! We work extremely hard to make it go as smoothly as possible for everyone. The recital typically lasts about 2 to 2 1/2 hours, and there is no down time. We have music sets in between dances and intermission music and video.

Do I need to stay for the entire recital?

We encourage everyone to stay for the entire show. At the end of the show, we do a final curtain call for all of our dancers. We bring them onstage to recognize them for all of their hard work. They take a final bow, and they are given a medal from the studio as a keepsake to commemorate the event.

Does my dancer need to stay backstage the entire show?

If your dancer is in both parts of the show—before and after intermission—then yes, we will require your dancer to remain backstage. If your dancer is only in the first half (before intermission), you may “check him/her out backstage during intermission and bring him/her back five dances before the end of the show. If your dancer is in the last half of the show, you may check him/her in backstage and receive your armbands during intermission.

What will my dancer do while waiting to perform?

There will be staff members or volunteers assigned to each dressing room and we always have televisions and DVD players—and usually Disney movies!—plus light snacks and water for dancers in the dressing rooms. Also, the Performing Arts Center has televisions in each dressing room which allow dancers to watch what is happening onstage, so your dancer can see and hear the recital from backstage.
